By default, installing Kubuntu will erase all existing software and data from your computer. If this is not what you want, you can install Kubuntu alongside your existing operating system instead. Follow the instructions carefully during installation to do this. If you prefer to try out Kubuntu from a Windows installation without repartitioning your hard disk, put the CD in the drive while Windows is running and select "install inside Windows" when the installation screen appears.
